

CORT Training Cycle

BLST

- Annual
- New attorneys (licensed or not)

Litigation Planning

- Annual (if needed)
- Attorneys with 1 ½ years of practice after admission
- Mandatory prerequisite for TAST

TAST

- Annual (if needed)
- Attorneys with at least 1 ½ years of practice after admission
- Prerequisites: Lit Planning & an acceptable trial notebook

Negotiations

- Bi-annual (alternates with Discovery)
- Attorneys with at least 2 years of experience
- Pre-requisite: BLST

Discovery

- Bi-annual (alternates with Negotiations)
- Attorneys with at least 2 years of experience after admission
- Pre-requisite: BLST

Federal Litigation/Affirmative Litigation

- Three year cycle
- Attorneys with at least 3 years of experience after admission

Advanced TAST

- Three year cycle
- Attorneys with 5+ years of experience after admission
- Significant trial experience

Management Trainings

- Two – three year cycle
- May alternate between basic and advanced packages and/or managers' conference
- Co-sponsored with MIE
- Attorneys with management and/or other leadership responsibilities

Substantive Law Trainings

- Annual – 2 – 3 subjects per year (alternate Family, Housing, Consumer, and Public Benefits)
- Repeat topics on a 2 – 3 year cycle
- Open to attorneys and paralegals

Advanced Substantive Law Trainings (as needed)

- At least one per year
- Rotating topics
- Open to attorneys and paralegals who have sufficient experience in this practice area
- Use of national speakers

Migrant Farmworker Training

- Annual
